## **OVERVIEW:**

**The BCFA has the following value as a part of the 2010-2015 Strategic Plan:**

**Value:** Safety for all participants.

To ensure the safety of participants, particularly vulnerable populations, and to meet Government of British Columbia Funding requirements, the BCFA requires that criminal record checks be done for all BCFA directors and employees and members whose role bring them into contact with vulnerable populations.

## **POLICY**

The following are required to undergo a Criminal Record Check (CRC) on an annual basis. The results of the CRC must be made available to the BCFA upon request.

- BCFA Board of Directors
- BCFA Employees (i.e. Provincial Coaches)
- Any BCFA member paid by the BCFA to perform a service where such a service involves contact with vulnerable populations. (EG, Coaches of development programs, referees and officials)
- Any BCFA member providing a volunteer service where such a service involves contact with vulnerable populations. (EG, tournament volunteers)
- Any person acting in a coaching capacity at a BCFA member club
